Eligible student must:


- Live within the boundaries of San Joaquin County or Stanislaus County, California.
- Be currently enrolled at Modesto Junior College
- Be planning to continue art education at a 4-year college or university program in the Fall of 2024, with a focus on Ceramic Pottery or Ceramic Sculpture.
- Submit application and required documents by the deadline date.

2024 Scholarship Timeline:

February 2024	Applications available online at: www.sjds.org and distributed to professors at Modesto Junior College who teach in the areas of Ceramic Pottery and Ceramic Sculpture.
May 6, 2024	DEADLINE FOR submission of application and artwork digital photos for scholarship applicants to submit detailed contact information and a copy of their letter of acceptance into the art program of a 4-year college or university.
May 10 – June 3, 2024	San Joaquin Potters Guild reviews applications and selects winner.
June 17, 2024	Presentation of winning application to the San Joaquin Potters Guild membership.
June 24, 2024	Scholarship winner will be notified and asked to attend July 15 San Joaquin Potters Guild meeting.
July 15, 2023	Scholarship presented at the meeting of the San Joaquin Potters Guild.

Application submission requirements:

The student must submit:

- This <u>completed</u> application form and required documentation.
- Each applicant must submit a minimum of 3 pieces of ceramic art in a digital format. Each entry may include 2-3 digital photos showing details of all sides of the artwork. (Reviewers may request original artwork for judging.)
- Artist's statement including process used. The artist's statement is limited to a maximum of 350 words.
- One letter of recommendation from your art instructor at your current educational institution (to include their current contact information).
- Letter of acceptance from the 4 yr. college/university you will be attending.

Incomplete scholarship applications may be disqualified
